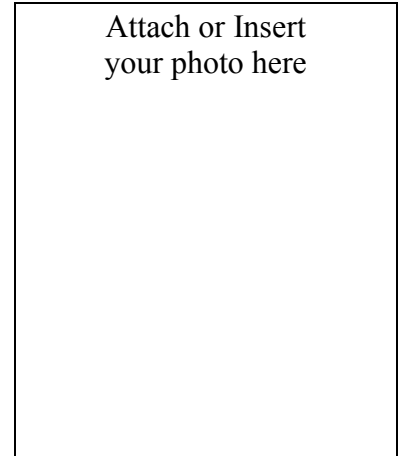

- **Graduate Credits from University of Mary:** If students enroll through Option 1 rather than Option 2, it will still be possible to request and make payment for graduate credits from the University of Mary at any time up to five years following successful completion of the NCBC Certification Program.
- **Graduate Credits from Holy Apostles College & Seminary:** If students enroll through Option 1 it will still be possible to request and make payment for graduate credits from Holy Apostles College & Seminary at any time up to six years following successful completion of the NCBC Certification Program.
